Successful Completion of Math & Science Prerequisite Courses

Bonus Points are awarded for successfully completing the following courses with a <u>C or better</u> on the first attempt: Anatomy and Physiology I and II; Chemistry I and II; Microbiology; and College Algebra. Bonus points are lost for repeating these courses even if a Grade Replacement is used and/or they are repeated at ECU or other schools. Only letter grades (not Pass/Fail grades) will be accepted for the courses noted that require a C or better. Therefore, Pass/Fail grades in any one of the courses listed above will not be eligible for bonus points in this category.

Successful Completion of BIOL Courses on First Attempt

Bonus Points are only awarded for successfully completing the following lectures and labs with a <u>B or better</u> on the first attempt: *Anatomy and Physiology I and II and Microbiology*. Points are not given for repeating these courses even if a Grade Replacement is used and/or they are repeated at ECU or other schools. Pass/Fail grades will not be eligible for the bonus point.


