REQUIRED GENERAL EDUCATION AND PREREQUISITE COURSES

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

To be an eligible ABSN applicant, you must meet ALL the following

criteria: Earned at least a Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university by the end of summer semester

- Minimum cumulative GPA/20+ credits post-graduation GPA of a 3.0
 - o The College of Nursing includes all college grades from all colleges attended when calculating GPA for admission; some exceptions may apply
- A final grade of B- or higher in these specific prerequisite courses:
 - o MATH 1065, CHEM 1120, CHEM 1130, BIOL 2140 & 2141, BIOL 2150 & 2151, and BIOL 2110 & 2111
 - BIOL2140/2141 and BIOL2150/2151 must be no older than 5 years at the time of the application deadline
 - o Pass/fail grades are not acceptable for these specific course requirements
 - o ECU requires a grade of C or higher to transfer credit officially for all coursework completed at other institutions
- Completed all, or be enrolled in, final set of and prerequisite courses listed above at the time of application submission
 - o If any courses are outstanding at the time of application submission, your application will not be considered, and you will receive an ineligible notification from the Office of Student Services.
 - o It is the applicant's responsibility to confirm they have completed, or are enrolled in, the correct equivalent courses to meet program requirements before submitting their application
- Completed at least one attempt on the HESI A2 pre-nursing entrance exam
- Submit a complete online application with all required documents by the application deadline, June 15th at 5:00pm.

• A fully completed copy of this eligibility worksheet

- Unofficial transcript(s) from each college attended for verification
- PDF copy HESI-A2 Report

If you have already requested/received an Unofficial Transcript Review by the CON Student Services within the past year, please indicate in your email request the date you received your completed unofficial evaluation from our office.

Please allow one to two business weeks for eligibility review and reception of link.
